Ordinance No. 1822

Sanitation Trash & Garbage Ordinance for The Town of Mountain City

Section 1. Trash must be beside the city curb by 7:00am. Amount of trash allowed for pick-up is 6 normal size (13-gallon size) plastic bags per can or 3 large size (33-gallon size) plastic bags per can at each residence. Maximum weight is **50 lbs.** per can/bag. All trash and cardboard must fit in plastic. If Trash route isn't run by the city for a scheduled holiday these limits will double. There will be a surcharge of \$5.00 per bag over the limit. 1st offense will be a warning letter. 2nd offense will have an adjustment to customers' water / garbage bill.

Section 2. Trash must be accessible to be picked up and in bags. Trash outside of bags or which has escaped bags for any reason must be picked up within 24 hours and rebagged by the Resident or Business.

Section 3. The following items will not be picked-up: large cardboard boxes, furniture, wood products, building materials, and motor vehicle parts, paint, oil and undrained oil filters, hazardous materials and this is not an exhaustive list of items.

Section 4. Businesses with excessive amounts of trash will have to use a (4-7 Yard) dumpster or equivalent 96 gallon trash cans, either serviced by the city or outside vendor limits per pickup will be 9 large size (33-gallon size) plastic bags per can/container

Section 5. The town's safety policy for our employee's health and safety is addressing concerns from needle sticks.

The garbage truck service workers will not pick up any trash containing loose Needles, Sharps, and Lancing Devices. These items must be placed in a plastic container with a secure lid. Any Resident or Business trash found with these items will be banned from City Trash Pick-up.


A notice will be placed on the trash can and a letter send to the customer. Customers found in violation must submit a plan of action to be reinstated.
